

BY-LAW NO. 186-06

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to amend By-law No. 62, as amended, being a by-law with respect to parking. (PRIVATE PROPERTY)

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, C. 25, S. 11(2) TABLE, Paragraph 10, and S. 100 and S. 101 authorizes the passing of by-laws with respect to parking;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacted By-law No. 62 on the 7th day of November, 1988, and has enacted amendments thereto;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend By-law No. 62;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. By-law No. 62 of The Corporation of the City of Cambridge, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting everything after the words " By-law 62 of The Corporation of The City of Cambridge" and substituting in it's place the following:

PART I – DEFINITIONS

- 1. The definitions contained in the *Highway Traffic Act*, R. S. O. 1990, c. H. 8, as amended, shall apply in the interpretation of this By-law except where such definitions are inconsistent with this By-law, in which case the definitions herein apply.

In this by-law:

- 1. **"Authorized Sign"** means any sign placed or erected under the authority of this By-law and the authority of the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works or his/her designate, for the purpose of regulating parking.
- 2. **"City"** means The Corporation of the City of Cambridge;
- 3. **"Commercial Motor Vehicle"** means a motor vehicle having permanently attached thereto a truck or delivery body and includes ambulances, hearses, fire apparatus, buses, and tractors used for hauling purposes on the highways.
- 4. **"Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works"** means the person appointed to that position by the City;
- 5. **"Enforcing Authority"** means either of the Waterloo Regional Police Service or the City;

6. **"Enforcing Official"** means:
- i. a police officer;
 - ii. a police cadet;
 - iii. a civilian person engaged by the Waterloo Regional Police Service;
 - iv. a by-law enforcement officer;
 - v. a Provincial Offences Officer;
 - vi. a municipal law enforcement officer engaged by the City to enforce the provisions of this by-law or any parts thereof;
 - vii. with respect to identified properties, as identified in **Schedule "A"** to this By-law, a municipal law enforcement officer whose name appears in **Schedule "A"** of this By-law; or,
 - viii. any person or class of persons designated pursuant to the *Provincial Offences Act*.
7. **"Motor Vehicle"** includes an automobile, motorcycle, motor assisted bicycle and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power, but does not include a street car, or other motor vehicles running only upon rails, or a motorized snow vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, self-propelled implement of husbandry or road-building machine.
8. **"Municipal Parking Lot"** means accommodation provided by the City for the parking of motor vehicles off the street or highway and open for public use with or without payment as listed and shown in **Schedule "B"** hereof.
9. **"Ontario Veterans Licence Plate"** - means a licence plate issued by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario to a vehicle owned by a Veteran, and which, at the time of parking, was driven by a Veteran or a Veteran was a passenger therein;
10. **"Occupant"**, when used in relation to real property, means,
- i. the tenant of the property or part thereof whose consent shall extend only to the control of the land of which they are a tenant and any parking spaces allotted to them under their lease or tenancy agreement.
 - ii. the spouse of a tenant.
 - iii. a person or a municipality, or a local board thereof, having an interest in the property under an easement or right-of-way granted to or expropriated by the person, municipality, or local board whose consent shall extend only to the part of the property that is subject to the easement or right-of-way.
 - iv. a person authorized in writing by an occupant as defined in sub-subclause (i), (ii), or (iii) to act on the occupant's behalf for requesting the enforcement of this By-law.

11. **"Owner"**, when used in relation to real property, means:
- i. the registered owner of the property.
 - ii. the registered owner of a condominium unit, whose consent shall extend only to the control of the owner's unit and any parking spaces allotted to the owner by the condominium corporation or reserved for the owner's exclusive use in the declaration or description of the property.
 - iii. the spouse of a person described in sub-subclause (i) or (ii).
 - iv. where the property is included in a description registered under the Condominium Act, the board of directors of the condominium corporation.
 - v. a person authorized in writing by the property owner as defined in sub-subclause (i),(ii), (iii), or (iv) to act on the owner's behalf for requesting the enforcement of this By-law.
12. **"Parking Token"** means a token approved by the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works for use in a parking meter or in other parking control devices.
13. **"Park" or "Parking"** means the standing of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.
14. **"Privately Owned Parking Lot"** means accommodation provided on private property for the parking of motor vehicles.
15. **"Parking Meter"** means:
- i. a device that can indicate thereon the length of time during which a vehicle may be parked and which shall have as parts thereof:
 - (1) a receptacle for receiving and storing coins or parking meter tokens;
 - (2) a slot or place in which such coins or tokens may be deposited;
 - (3) a timing mechanism to measure the passage of the interval of time during which the parking is permissible; and
 - (4) which displays a signal when said interval of time shall have elapsed; or,
 - ii. a device which will produce a receipt indicating the length/amount of parking time purchased and which produces a receipt indicating the amount of parking time purchased.
16. **"Parking Meter Zone"** means the Municipal Parking Lots or parts of Municipal Parking Lots designated from time to time constituting a Parking meter zone, as shown on **Schedule "B"** hereto.
17. **"Parking Permit"** means a decal or specially designed card authorized from time to time by the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works or his/her designate that allows special parking privileges and includes:

- i. **"Courtesy Permit"** which permits the parking of a motor vehicle, without payment, in any space (except a reserved and a disabled space) in any municipal parking lot from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the date indicated thereon;
 - ii. **"24/7 Permit"** which permits the parking of a motor vehicle, without payment, in any space (except a reserved space or a disabled space) in the municipal parking lot indicated on the permit twenty-four (24) hours per day during the year indicated thereon;
 - iii. **"Day Time Permit"** which permits the parking of a motor vehicle, without payment, in any reserved or other space (except disabled) in the municipal parking lot indicated thereon from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. of each day;
 - iv. **"Car Pool Permit"** which permits the parking of a motor vehicle in any parking space designated as "Pool Permit" in the municipal parking lot indicated thereon.
18. **"Parking Space"** means a portion of the surface of a municipal parking lot or privately owned parking lot showing by pavement markings a space for the parking of a motor vehicle.
19. **"Reserved Parking Space"** means a parking space located:
- i. in a municipal parking lot as shown on **Schedule "B"** hereto; or
 - ii. in a privately owned parking lot; and
 - iii. which is identified by authorized signs indicating such space to be for the exclusive use of vehicles displaying a Parking Permit authorized by such signs.

PART II – REGULATIONS

Property other than Municipal Parking Lots

1. Application

The provisions of this Part shall apply to:

- a. property owned or occupied privately; and
- b. to property owned or occupied by the City or any local Board thereof;

but shall not apply to municipal parking lots owned, leased or operated by the City.

2. No Parking

No person shall park a motor vehicle on private property without the consent of the owner or occupant of the property nor on property owned or occupied by the City or any local Board thereof without the consent of the City or local Board, as the case may be.

3. Written Complaint

The driver or owner of a motor vehicle parked on private property is not liable to a penalty or to have the motor vehicle removed from such property or impounded except upon the written complaint of the owner or occupant of the property given to a police officer, police cadet or municipal law enforcement officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of this By-law.

4. **Signs**

Where an owner or occupant of property has posted signs referring to this By-law and stating conditions on which a motor vehicle may be parked on the property or prohibiting the parking of a motor vehicle on the property, a motor vehicle parked on the property contrary to such conditions or prohibition shall be deemed to have been parked without consent.

PART III – REGULATIONS

Municipal Parking Lots

1. **Application to Municipal Parking Lots**

a. The provisions of this part shall apply to City owned, leased or operated municipal parking lots, more particularly described in **Schedule "B"** attached hereto.

b. The provisions of this part do not apply to:

- i. an emergency vehicle as defined within the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. H. 8, as amended;
- ii. a vehicle owned by the City of by the Regional Municipality of Waterloo while actively engaged in performing municipal duties; or
- iii. vehicle owned by a public utility (including hydro, gas, water, telephone and cable) while actively engaged in performing utility services.

c. **Un-expired Time**

Any person may use the un-expired time remaining in a parking meter from its previous use.

d. **Signs**

The Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works or his/her designate is hereby authorized to place, erect, display and maintain such signs as are required to give effect to the provisions of this By-law.

e. **Substitute Coins**

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slug, device or other substitute for a coin of the Dominion of Canada or the United States of America other than the approved City parking tokens.

2. **Parking Offences**

a. **Exceed Time Period**

Between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive, no person, including persons with Disabled Parking Permits, shall park in any parking space in any Municipal Parking Lot for a continuous period in excess of the maximum time shown in **Schedule "C"** unless the parking space is designated by an authorized sign that is on display as allowing longer parking for Parking Permits.

b. Payment

Save and except for persons displaying an Ontario Veterans Licence Plate, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., from Monday to Saturday inclusive, no person shall park a motor vehicle at a parking meter zone in any municipal parking lot unless the fee set out in **Schedule "C"** to this By-law has been deposited in the parking meter for the parking space and, where appropriate, the receipt indicating the length/amount of parking time purchased has been clearly displayed in the motor vehicle.

c. Exceed Paid Time

No person shall park a motor vehicle at a parking meter zone for a longer period than the period for which payment has been made in the parking meter.

d. Parking Permit

No person shall park a motor vehicle in any parking space that is indicated, by an authorized sign that is on display, as "Permit Parking" unless the vehicle is displaying a valid Parking Permit for that parking space.

e. Fees for Parking Permits

The fee for Parking Permits for each parking lot is as set out in **Schedule "C"** to this By-law.

f. Overnight Parking

Unless a proper Parking Permit is on display, no person shall park a motor vehicle in any Municipal Parking Lot at any time between the hours of 2:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. from December 1st to March 31st inclusive in each year.

g. Market Square

Notwithstanding the preceding provision, no person shall park a motor vehicle from 2:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. at any time during the year in the Market Square Lot.

h. Aisles

No person shall park a motor vehicle on any roadway or aisle in any Municipal Parking Lot.

i. Access Roadway

No person shall Park a motor vehicle along an access roadway to a Municipal Parking Lot.

j. In Parking Space

No person shall park a motor vehicle in a Municipal Parking Lot except in a parking space designated by markers or painted lines and as nearly in the centre of the parking space as possible.

k. **No Commercial Activity**

No person shall use any portion of any Municipal Parking Lot for the purpose of buying or selling merchandise or services or repairing of vehicles unless authorized in writing by the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works or his/her designate.

l. **Distribute Literature or Handbills**

No person shall distribute literature or deposit handbills on or into any motor vehicle in any Municipal Parking Lot unless authorized in writing by the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works or his/her designate.

m. **Obstruction**

No person shall park a motor vehicle in such a position as to prevent the convenient removal of any other motor vehicle previously parked or stopped.

n. **Size and Weight**

Unless authorized in writing by the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Works or his/her designate, no person shall park a motor vehicle in a Municipal Parking Lot which vehicle has:

- i. an overall length of more than 6 meters; or
- ii. an overall width of more than 2.5 meters; or
- iii. an overall weight greater than 1600 kilograms.

For the purposes of this By-law, the length and width of a motor vehicle shall include the length and width of any load carried by such motor vehicle.

o. **Temporary Stopping**

No person shall park or stop a motor vehicle in a Municipal Parking Lot area designated by an authorized sign that is on display as a "No Parking" or "Loading" zone except that a driver of a motor vehicle may temporarily stop in these zones for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in loading or unloading goods or passengers, provided that such stopping does not interfere with any other motor vehicle waiting to enter or about to enter these zones.

p. **Expired Parking Permits**

The displaying of illegible, expired, cancelled or altered Parking Permits for the purpose of a valid Parking Permit is prohibited.

q. **Lost Parking Permit**

The displaying of a Parking Permit which has been lost by its lawful owner or stolen from its lawful owner, for the purpose of a valid Parking Permit by a person knowing such permit has been lost by its lawful owner or stolen from its lawful owner is prohibited.

3. **Moving Offences**

a. **Direction**

A person shall drive in a Municipal Parking Lot only in the direction indicated by signs or pavement markings and shall drive only on the roadways.

b. **Speed**

No person shall drive on any roadway in a Municipal Parking Lot at a speed greater than 15 kilometers per hour.

c. **Entrances and Exits**

No person shall drive into or leave a Municipal Parking Lot at other than the designated entrances and exits.

d. **Endanger**

No person shall use any portion of a Municipal Parking Lot in a manner so as to endanger the person or property of another.

PART IV – ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY

1. **Offences**

a. Any person who contravenes any provision of Part II of this By-law is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 33, as amended;

b. The set fine for each offence under Part II herein is set out in **Schedule “D”** of this By-law;

c. Any person who contravenes any provision of Part III of this by-law is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O., 1990, c. P. 33, as amended.

d. The set fine for each offence under Part III herein is set out in **Schedule “E”** of this By-law;

e. If the set fine is not paid within the time period required, the procedures of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O., 1990, c. P. 33, as amended, shall apply.

f. All provisions of this By-law may be enforced by Enforcing Officials provided that moving offences may only be enforced by a police officer.

g. Notwithstanding the preceding provision, Enforcing Officials whose names appear in **Schedule “A”** hereto may enforce the provisions of this By-law only on a property the municipal address of which is listed beside their name in said **Schedule “A”**.

2. Removal of Vehicle

A Police Officer of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo Police Service upon discovery of any motor vehicle parked in contravention of the provisions of this By-law, may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the motor vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the *Repair and Storage Liens Act*, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter R. 25.

3. Owner and Driver

The driver of a motor vehicle, not being the owner, is liable for any penalty provided in this By-law and the owner of the motor vehicle is also liable to such penalty unless at the time the offence was committed the motor vehicle was in the possession of a person other than the owner without the consent of the owner.

PART V - GENERAL

1. Sever

Should any part, section or provision of this By-law be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not effect the validity of the By-law as a whole or in part thereof, other than the part which was declared to be invalid.


2. Citation
