



BY-LAW 19-015

of the

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a By-Law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to amend the Business Licence By-Law 142-16 (housekeeping amendments).

WHEREAS By-Law 142-16 was passed to regulate and govern any local business operating in the City of Cambridge;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge deems it expedient to amend By-Law 142-16 for the purposes of general housekeeping updates;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. THAT Clause (b)(12) in Section 3 (Licence Requirement Application) be amended to read as follows:
"Articles of incorporation or or sole proprietorship; master business license; insurance showing the prescribed amount as per required by the City's insurance pool; and any other similar information required by the Licensing Officer or specifically required pursuant to further sections of this by-law, or any law or Act for both initial and renewal licensing."
2. THAT Clause (b) in Section 4 (Validity of Licence) be amended to read as follows:
"Every Licence shall be subject to renewal annually upon payment (January 1st) of the appropriate renewal fee as noted in Schedule B and receipt of all information required by the Licensing Officer and this by-law. Every Licence shall be subject to an additional fee upon renewal payments after the determined date outlined in the renewal letter."


3. THAT Clause (a) in Section 8 (Display of Licence) be amended to read as follows:
“No Person shall carry on, engage in, or operate a business listed in Schedule C without displaying a Business Licence issued under this By-law in a conspicuous location meaning standing out so as to be clearly visible by a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, Licensing Officer, or member of the general public.”

4. THAT Schedule “B” to By-Law 142-16 be amended to read as follows:

Renewal of Licence Prior to January 1	75% of original fee – primary category and 75% of original fee – secondary and/or third category
Processing of Late Registrations (After date indicated on renewal letter)	50% of original fee
Transfer of a Licence (new location)	Cost of original fee
Transfer of a Licence (new owner)	50% of original fee
Addition of Business Categories	Cost of primary category is original fee Cost of a secondary and/or third category is 50% of the fee

5. THAT this By-Law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
